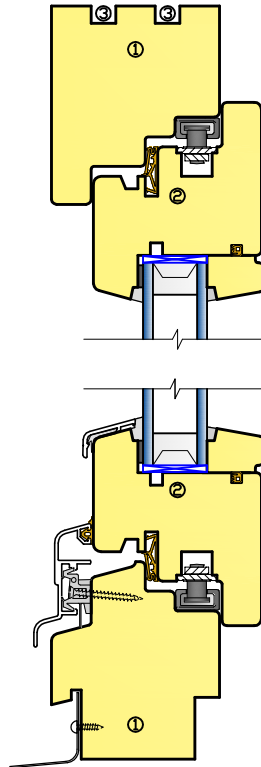
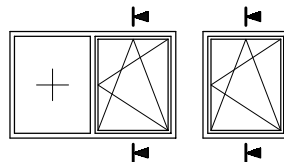


STANDARD WOODEN WINDOW (TIMBER WINDOW) HTP-1



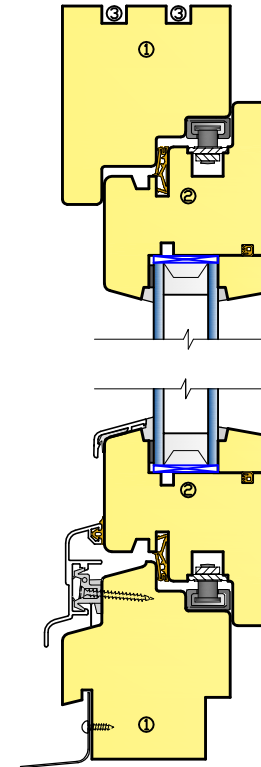
- window thermal conductivity $U-1,61 \text{ W/m}^2\text{K}^*$
- glass thermal conductivity $U-1,4 \text{ W/m}^2\text{K}$
- 1 x seal
- 2 x glass **26mm** (4mm clear + 4mm clear/LowE)
- 1 x 18mm aluminium glass spacer profile
- 1 x air filling

- ① window frame
- ② window sash
- ③ assembly foam grooves (at the sides and upper edge of the window frame)



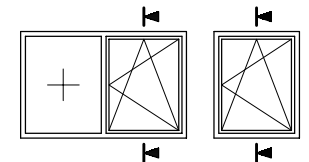

SPECIAL WOODEN WINDOW (TIMBER WINDOW) HTP-2



- window thermal conductivity $U-1,37 \text{ W/m}^2\text{K}^*$
- glass thermal conductivity $U-1,1 \text{ W/m}^2\text{K}$
- 1 x seal
- 2 x glass **26mm** (4mm clear + 4mm clear/LowE)
- 1 x 18mm aluminium glass spacer profile
- 1 x argon filling

- ① window frame
- ② window sash
- ③ assembly foam grooves (at the sides and upper edge of the window frame)
